

# **DRAG STRIP & MILE-OVAL RULES** Event: **HOT ROD ROCK & RUMBLE**

***These rules are intended to promote an enjoyable & safe time for all participants at the Event. Please use common sense to drive safely – for you, your passengers, and others at the Event.***

**SPEED LIMIT:** The speed limit in the Paddock, Infield and Midway is 5 MPH. Be careful to drive safely around pedestrians. Be on the lookout for pedestrians that do not see you. **The speed limit on the Mile-Oval is 45 MPH and traffic circulates clockwise.** Speeding will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the event.

**WAIVERS:** Each driver and passenger must sign the PPIR waiver before being allowed to enter the Drag Strip staging lanes or the Mile-Oval. Participants who sign the waiver will receive a yellow checkered wrist band. A PPIR Drag Strip Official will have the waiver available for signature at the Turn 1 track entrance.

## **DRAG STRIP:**

- Drivers will access the staging lanes at Turn 1 of the oval and **stay to the right** to line up for the drag strip.
- If two drivers wish to race against each other, drivers are to line up in the same staging lane, nose to tail, and notify a PPIR Drag Strip Official.
- VHT or any other form of traction compound is prohibited.
- Burnouts are permitted under the Stage. No water for burnouts is permitted.
- After each Drag Strip finish, slow to 25 mph and merge with Mile-Oval cruise at the end of the wall on your left. Speeding will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the event.
- Do not stop on the Drag Strip or on the Oval.
- For high speed drag runs, both driver & passenger (1 passenger allowed) must use an adequate seat belt.
- Any person exhibiting unsafe behavior may be ejected from the event at PPIR's sole discretion.

## **CRUISING THE OVAL:**

- Enter the Oval through the Track Entrance at Turn 1 (same as the drag cars) and **stay to the left**.
- Drag cars finishing their passes will merge with Oval cruise traffic at the end of the drag strip.
- Do not stop on the Oval. No speeding, racing, burnouts or donuts!

## **PASSENGERS:**

- Passengers are allowed in vehicles for the Mile-Oval cruise or for lower speed drag runs.
- Each passenger must have their own seat in the vehicle. The allowance or further restriction of passengers in any vehicle is at the sole discretion of PPIR.
- Only one passenger is allowed for high speed drag runs. Both the passenger and driver must be secured with adequate safety seat belts for

## **VEHICLE SAFETY INFORMATION:**

- It is the responsibility of the driver to ensure that his or her vehicle is track worthy.
- PPIR reserves the right at any time during the event to not allow any vehicle on track.

**ALCOHOL & DRUGS:** By attending the Event, you agree to not operate a vehicle anywhere at the Event if you are under the influence of alcohol, recreational drugs or narcotics. No alcoholic beverages, recreational drugs or narcotics are permitted in vehicles driven at the Event, on the Dragstrip, at the Burnout Circus or on the Mile-Oval.

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY:** By operating a vehicle at the Event including the Dragstrip or Mile-Oval Track (the "Tracks"), you agree to release and hold harmless Pikes Peak International Raceway LLC and Raceway 200 LLC ("PPIR") and any of its employees, managers and owners from any liability whatsoever in connection with you operating a vehicle at the Event or on the Tracks. Furthermore, prior to driving at the Event or on the Tracks, you agree to execute, and have any passengers in your vehicle agree to execute, a **RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT** in favor of PPIR.

**PPIR RULES & REGULATIONS:** All persons at PPIR are subject to the Raceway's posted general rules & regulations. By entering PPIR, you agree that PPIR has the right to restrict any activity or eject from the premises persons, vehicles and equipment that PPIR's staff believes is a nuisance or menace to property and other persons.
