

CAMPING INFORMATION & RULES



These rules are intended to promote an enjoyable & safe time for all campers at PPIR. Please be considerate of your fellow campers – even better, get to know them and enjoy your stay!

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY: Call 911 – your location is Pikes Peak International Raceway - City of Fountain - Interstate 25 at Exit #122. Note where you are – Zone #, infield or outside the oval track.

YOUR CAMPSITE SPACE: Your RV, camper trailer, tow vehicle/tow-behind vehicle, outdoor furniture, metal fire pits, BBQ's, camping gear, awnings, tents, generators must fit within your Campsite. No parking outside your space except race/show cars may remain in the paddock/show car field. Complimentary parking for your car trailer or extra vehicles will be provided elsewhere at PPIR. Vehicles without an appropriate pass are subject to removal.

24-HOUR ACCESS: Previously checked-in campers have 24-hour access in & out of PPIR – a Campsite Pass is required for your RV/Camper Trailer and Tow Vehicle/Tow-Behind; and all persons are required to have an appropriate event wristband for access.

CHECKOUT TIME: Checkout Time is as published in the Event Schedule. Contact the Camp Manager if you need to stay later or park a vehicle for later pick up. There may be an additional charge and/or relocation.

NOISE: Please be courteous to your neighbors and keep your noise level down between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM.

ELECTRICITY: Electrical hookups are only for campers who have paid for them. Lite-Power power is 120V-20A via a typical household outlet. RV-Power is 120V-30A or 220V-50A via a typical 30A or 50A RV outlet (not twist-lock). By connecting to PPIR's power, you agree that PPIR is not liable for damage or injury caused by connection to PPIR's power or for failure of the connection to provide power to your camper, RV or equipment. Campers that repeatedly trip circuit breakers due to overload or faults will have power disconnected without refund. Persons making unauthorized connection to an electrical outlet will be charged \$250 per instance and subject to ejection from PPIR.

GENERATORS: You may run your quiet, non-smoky generator at any time. Please be considerate of your camping neighbor about generator noise/exhaust. By camping at PPIR, you agree to turn off your generator at PPIR's request.

ICE & WATER & DUMP STATION: Ice is available at the Info Center. Non-potable water fill stations and dumpsites are onsite – see Camping Map. Vac-truck service is available at larger events and will take \$25 cash only - ask at Check-In. Any camper dumping sewage, gray or black water on the ground or in storm drains shall pay PPIR a minimum of \$500 clean up fee.

TRASH: PPIR will pick up bagged trash from the edge of your campsite once a day. There will be a minimum charge of \$100 to clean up your Campsite if you leave behind un-bagged trash or camping gear.

CAMPFIRES & BBQ'S: Campfires in elevated metal firepits and BBQ grills are allowed, subject to local fire restrictions in effect. No campfires shall be made directly on the ground or pavement. Any camper with a fire pit or BBQ grill must have a fire extinguisher available nearby for immediate use. No dumping of ashes, charcoal or cinders is allowed. Campers are responsible for any damage or injury caused by smoke or fire on or from their Campsite.

RESTROOMS & SHOWERS: Infield: Restrooms and showers are located on the north side of the South Garage building, center of the Infield. Outside of Oval: Restrooms are located west of the grandstands. During larger events, temporary toilets may be located near the camping areas.

ALCOHOL: Per Colorado law, persons must be at least 21 years of age to consume alcoholic beverages and it is unlawful to provide alcoholic beverages to a minor. No alcoholic beverages may be brought into the interior oval of the event. No alcoholic beverages acquired within the interior oval of the event may be brought outside of that area.

PETS: All pets must be on leash or within a motorhome or camping trailer. Pets are not allowed to be left unattended in a tent. Please clean up after your pet. PPIR may designate areas, events or programs where pets are not allowed. PPIR's Dog Park is located next to the Infield Tunnel, inside Turn 2 of the Oval. You are liable for any damage or injury your pet causes. By camping at PPIR, you agree to remove your pet from PPIR at PPIR's request.

SECURITY: Lock and secure your vehicles and your property. Keep your valuables out of sight. By entering PPIR you agree that PPIR is not responsible for theft, loss or damage to your vehicle or personal property.

PPIR RULES & REGULATIONS: All persons at PPIR are subject to the Raceway's posted general rules & regulations. By camping at PPIR, the camper agrees to be responsible for the behavior and actions of any person the camper permits in his/her campsite. By entering PPIR, the camper agrees that PPIR has the right to restrict any activity or eject from the premises persons, vehicles and equipment that PPIR's staff believes is a nuisance or menace to property and other persons.

PPIR wants you to have a great time - these common-sense rules are intended for everyone's benefit.
